THE square head on Nike's SQ SUMO² Fairway Wood increases your chances of hitting a straight shot from any lie as it distributes weight to the farthest corners of the club. There's also a nice big sweet spot on the Cryo steel face, while the Diamana shaft, favoured by many Tour pros, comes in with either a regular or stiff flex. WWG was initially sceptical as to whether the new square version would live up to its more traditionally shaped predecessor but we found it to be a wonderful addition to the bag. The square head comes in particularly useful when lining up shots.

SensoGlove

WHEN WWG heard that there was a glove on the market that actually tells you when your grip is incorrect we had to find out more. The SensoGlove is a remarkable creation. It looks and feels just like a regular glove but includes highly responsive and strategically placed sensors, which measure grip pressure 80 times per second. The sensors then feed the data into a small computer attached to the back of the glove. If you grip the club too tightly – one of the fundamental causes of an over-tense and jerky swing – the computer emits a loud audio signal, warning you to ease off. Clever eh? The computer's 3 cm wide screen also provides an instant visual readout to indicate whether too much grip pressure is being applied.

The sensitivity of the glove can be altered between 'low' and 'high' with the highest settings (13-18) promoting a very light grip. The result is that players with a tendency to grip the club too tightly – of whom there are many – learn to relax the muscles to the optimum degree in order to produce a smooth, natural swing. The SensoGlove is made from high-quality cabretta leather. When it gets worn out, you simply order a replacement from www.SensoGlove.com and easily snap the battery-operated minicomputer into the back of the new glove. The glove is available in men's and ladies left-hand only, in sizes S-XL, and if you're quick, you can snap one up for a special introductory price until the end of the Ryder Cup (September 21) – which will be extended by four weeks if the European Team wins!
